## Chairman's Report 2014-2015

Your Parish Council continues to do what it can to reflect your views and to act in your best interests. I am honoured to serve as its Chairman and I wish to thank all parishioners who have shared their views and concerns with us over the past year.

This year has seen no major planning issues for this parish, apart from some enforcement issues brought to our attention, but we have expressed our views regarding developments regarding the Beeston Market site that many of you overlook. Work on our Neighbourhood Plan, in co-operation with Beeston, has progressed well under the excellent stewardship of Councillor Cheshireand our Parish Clerk, Phil Sanders. My thanks go to them and also to all of you who responded to our second questionnaire of the year concerning Neighbourhood Plan policies.

I am pleased that we finally saw long-needed improvements to the road surface and drainage in the vicinity ofTownfield Lane. We are currently liaising with United Utilities about the frequency of interruptions to the water supply on Huxley Lane.

I am pleased to note that, over the last seven years or so, we have seen new members joining the Council as vacancies arose.
