At the last minute, Houghton Poultry at Tiverton Heath appealed the enforcement notice served on them and now have 6 months in which to develop their case for overturning the notice. This means that poultry rearing activities are likely to continue into 2008.

The spate of planning applications continues, with the Council taking a close interest in all construction work in the village to ensure that the proper regulatory processes are in place for the work being undertaken.

Chairman's Letter

Of concern to us all must be the on-going damage to our fences and verges caused by the large HGV's that have missed the low bridge signs and need to turn round in the wholly inadequate 'turning circle' at the junction of the A49 and Huxley Lane. A number of suggestions have been put forward which we have rejected, and you should know that your council has requested a site meeting with the authorities concerned to see if we can't come up with a definitive solution. I'll keep you informed.

Another issue with the A49 is the increasing incidence of 'fly-tipping' in the layby near to the Red Fox. This is becoming a particular problem and one that is proving difficult to capture. I would ask for renewed vigilance, and if anyone should observe anything even mildly suspicious, to record registration numbers and either forward to myself or any other councilor.

We have booked another loan of the radar speed gun for w/c 8th October but we are still looking for additional volunteers. If you are concerned about speeding in YOUR village now is your chance to do something about it.

For one reason and another we didn't manage a 'Village Day' this year, but if we are to rectify that next year then now is the time for preparation. To that end I propose to call a meeting in the village hall of interested parties on 16th October at 7:30pm, please come along.

Finally, your council and I exist solely to oversee the management of the parish and its affairs; we are at your bidding. If you have a problem or an issue you would like to reach a wider audience, then let us know, we will listen. Our meetings are usually held every other month and the dates are on the reverse of this pamphlet as well as notice boards and web site. You are cordially invited to join us, let's make this village OUR village, we can't do it alone.
