New Highways Internet Services

Road Works On-line

A new interactive map can be viewed on a County Council web page which shows all roadworks during a three month period.

Those of high impact which are likely to cause significant delays are ringed in yellow and all other roadworks have a triangle sign. By clicking onto them information is given about each one.

Try out www.cheshire.gov.uk/roadworks, could save you frustrating delays on your car journey.

Annoyed at the ever increasing number of potholes in our minor roads? Now you can at least report them via www.cheshire.gov.uk/roads/faultform. If the system doesn't know about the problem, it will never be sorted and maybe a number of reports about the same problem will move it up the priority list? There doesn't seem to be an increase in Highways budgets to cope with a new stream of reported problems, so the likelihood of a fast response is low.

Not to be outdone by Highways, the Fire Service has introduced a text messaging system to alert residents and businesses to major incidents in their area. Visit www.cheshirefire.gov.uk to register for this free service.

A New Bus Service for Tiverton

The A51 Shuttle bus now connects Tiverton with the C84 service at Tarporley and Tarvin. The A51 will wait at these two locations for the arrival of the C84 The important times are:

Going to Chester Tiverton 10:39 arr Chester 11:20 (change Tarvin)

Return from Chester: Chester 16:30 Tiverton 17:26 (change Tarvin)

Going to Crewe: Tiverton 11:50, arr Crewe 12:49 (change Tarporley)

Return from Crewe: Crewe 16:35 arr Tiverton 17:26 (change Tarporley)

This is a Monday to Saturday service. Just flag down the Whitegate Travel bus anywhere in the village. It will be heading in the direction you want to travel.

The Parish Council has worked hard to get the A51 routed through the village, now we hope that it will be used.

Some Hints and Tips for Christmas Recycling

- o Buy your fruit and veg loose, without packaging you can then pick the best ones too!
- o Use a re-usable shopping bag or re-use your old plastic bags when you brave the giant Christmas food shop.
- o Buy drinks in bigger bottles rather than smaller ones. One large bottle generates less waste than several smaller ones.
- o Make use of leftovers, or reduce the quantities by getting together with a neighbour or relative to share the large packs and special offers around at Christmas time.
- o Real Christmas trees less than 6ft can be collected with garden waste in the brown bags, or if rooted, planted in your garden in the New Year.
- o Christmas cards can go in the green bags. Or support the Woodland Trust who will have collection bins in many stores in January.
- o Don't forget the bottle bank at The Shady Oak if your glass collection bag is full.
- o Pass on any unwanted gifts to charity shops or sign up to Freecycle at creweandnantwichfreecycle@yahoogroups.com .
- o Look out for presents made from recycled materials or those that have recycled content.
- o Go for gift bags instead of wrapping paper these will be re-used on other occasions.
- o Stay traditional put presents in a stocking which will be re-used year on year.

And remember during your New Year celebrations - make a resolution to recycle more stuff, more often!
