

Garden Waste

Your garden bin collection

All Garden waste collections are suspended until further notice so that resources can be concentrated on maintaining your scheduled household refuse collection service. Household waste and recycling collections will take place as per schedule. Check when your recycling and black bin collections are (link:

Your garden waste collection questions answered.

Q How long is the service suspended for?

A Garden waste collections are suspended until further notice. We cannot confirm at this stage when garden collections will resume.

Q Now that the garden collections are postponed will my waste collections become more frequent?

A. Recycling and household waste collections will continue to take place on your scheduled collection days. There will be no additional household waste collections.

Q Where do I take garden waste to for disposal?

A The household waste recycling centres are open and will accept garden waste, however, please only visit the recycling centre if your visit is essential. Recycling centres are restricting the number of people allowed on site at any one time so queuing is likely. Find out where your nearest household waste recycling centre is and when it is open;

Q Am I able to obtain a second garden bin to contain the extra garden waste I produce?

A Residents are currently not able to order extra garden waste bins as we are unable to empty them.

Q I already have a second garden bin and have received a renewal payment letter. What should I do whilst garden waste collections are cancelled?

A The annual payment for second garden bins will not be taken until the garden waste service resumes. We will ensure residents only pay for a 12 month service, residents will be contacted advising them of when their payment is required.

Q I paid for an additional green bin two months ago, can I get a refund to cover the suspended collections?

A All annual renewals will be moved ahead by the number of weeks the service has been suspended by. For example, if a resident paid in February this year and we suspended for two months, their next renewal date would be April 2021

Q Can I place a small amount of garden waste into the domestic bin

A Yes, but make sure there is enough room for domestic waste. Composting is an easy cheap alternative to putting garden waste into the domestic waste bin.

Q Will I get a refund on my council tax?
