

I am writing to inform you that United Utilities has commenced a £500,000 project involving the installation of approximately two kilometres of new water mains in the Hargrave, Huxley, Tarporley, and Tiverton area.

The scheme is designed to improve the resilience and reliability of the local water network. The new water main will help to reduce leakage and provide greater protection against future bursts.

This project is one of several planned across the Greater Manchester region. The work will be delivered by Network Plus and carried out in sections along Chapel Lane, and Long Lane, Church Lane, Huxley Lane. Temporary traffic management will be in place at times to ensure the works are carried out safely.

Works commenced on Monday 5 January and are expected to take around 15 weeks to complete.

Local residents will receive hand-delivered letters providing further information about the works.
