

Good Afternoon,

We are writing to inform you of the next stages of our surface treatment programme on the **A49 Whitchurch Road, Tiverton**.

Following the recent patching works, we are moving into the surface dressing phase. To ensure the safety of our teams and the public, these works will require a full road closure. While the road will be closed to through traffic, we will be maintaining access for local businesses, residents, and emergency services. However, there may be minor delays.

Your Access Requirements We understand that maintaining business operations and access for your staff and customers is vital. If you have any specific access requirements, such as scheduled deliveries or essential staff access, speak directly to our operatives on-site on the day, and they will do their absolute best to accommodate you and minimize any disruption.

Work Schedule

- **Phase 2 (Surface Dressing):** Tuesday 28th April to Wednesday 29th April 2026
- **Working Hours:** 07:00 to 19:00 (Daytime working)
- **Phase 3 (Further Treatment):** Tuesday 5th May 2026 (Daytime working)
- **Phase 4 (Road Markings):** Dates to be confirmed

Key Information for Constituents

- **Access & Delays:** While the road will be closed to through traffic, access will be maintained throughout the day for residents, local businesses, and emergency services. We have encouraged anyone with specific access or delivery requirements to speak directly to our operatives on-site, who will do their best to assist and minimise delays.
- We are notifying local businesses along the route directly to ensure they can plan around the daytime closure. Residents have also been asked to ensure vehicles are moved off the carriageway by 07:00 on the day of the works.
- **Weather Dependency:** As these works are weather-dependent, the dates may be subject to change at short notice. We will update the large yellow information boards on-site with any amendments to ensure the community has the most current information.
- **Noise:** There will be some noise associated with the machinery and mandatory safety alarms on our vehicles. We appreciate the community's patience while we work to complete this phase as quickly as possible.
