

Good afternoon,

We are writing to inform you about upcoming carriageway maintenance and edge-stabilisation works on Tattenhall Road, Tattenhall.

Key details of the works:

- **Location:** Tattenhall Road, Tattenhall (from the entrance of Tattenhall Marina up to the junction with Hill Garth Road)
- **Start Date:** Week commencing 24th August 2026
- **Duration:** Approximately 2 weeks (until week commencing 14th September 2026)
- **Working Hours:** 07:00-17:00

Overview of Works:

The works involve the excavation and stabilisation of the carriageway edge (haunching) followed by full carriageway resurfacing. A full road closure is required with a signed diversion route in place for all vehicles to keep both our workforce and road users safe.

What to expect during these works:

- **Vehicle Access:** The road will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the works. Access for local residents and businesses will be maintained when it is safe to do so. Please speak directly to the team on site if you require access; there may be short delays while the site is made safe for vehicles to pass.
- **Pedestrians:** Pedestrian access will be safely maintained throughout the duration of the works.
- **Parking:** We kindly ask that vehicles are not parked on the street within the closure area **throughout the duration of the works**, as works cannot be completed next to parked cars.
- **Drying Time:** The new surface material requires 1 to 2 hours to fully set. Please allow time for the surface to harden before driving or walking on it.
- **Noise:** There will be operational noise during working hours due to equipment and mandatory vehicle reversing alarms, though the team will always try to keep disruption to a minimum.
- **Weather:** All works are weather-dependent, and schedules are subject to change.
